From Our Rector



I love the image of Jesus as shepherd. My ordination card has the well-known image of Him tenderly holding one lamb. Jesus' eyes are shut, His face mostly hidden. Your focus goes to the lamb, eyes open, and safe in the arms of his shepherd. I think it's important to notice that there is just one lamb in this picture. Yes, Jesus is concerned with His entire flock, but here we see Him embracing just one. The one that may have strayed away; the one that may have gotten inadvertently lost; the one who needed to be brought home.

The readings today remind us that Jesus cares for each one of us, as individuals. He "calls his own sheep by name." Most importantly, the author of Peter stresses that He "also suffered for you." This message is vital to understanding our relationship with Him. It is personal. I am worth searching the pasture; I am worth His suffering and even dying. This relationship is also universal – open to anyone who will follow him: "I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice."

As we sit at home, it is easy to feel lost and perhaps even a little forgotten. Even if you are sheltering with family members, you can still feel apart emotionally. Interior doors can be locked too. But my sisters and brothers, Jesus is at the gate, he IS the gate, calling you to him. He has not forgotten you. Do you recognize Him in the voices you hear live streaming the Mass? Do you recognize Him in the selfless acts of courage and compassion witnessed by medical personnel and front line workers? Do you recognize Him in the volunteers who bring food to the needy?

More importantly, can others recognize Him in you? In the outreach you make, checking on neighbors, family or friends? Do they recognize Him in your home as you knock on the door of a difficult family member?

Our days may be "virtual" now; but Christ's love is with you, and me. Listen for Him; he is calling your name. ~Fr. Posey
