
Liturgy of the Word



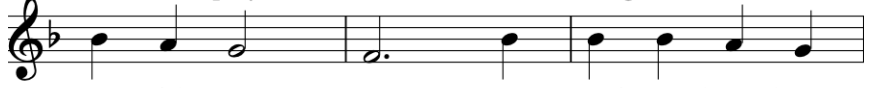
