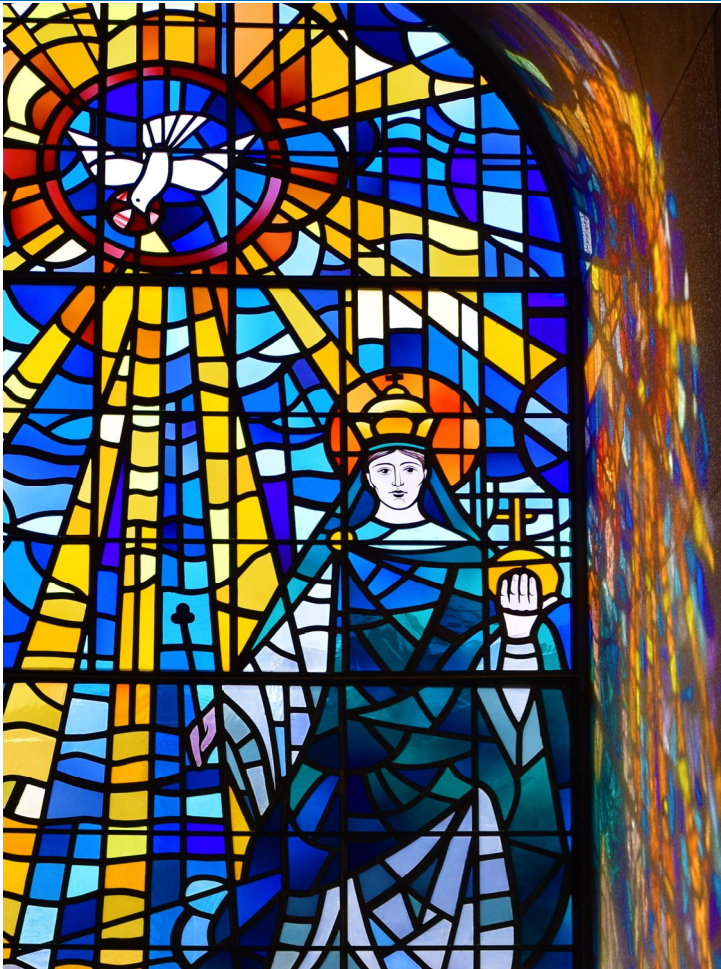

Today we celebrate the Assumption of our Blessed Mother, a holy day. We’re taught from an early age that when Mary died her entire self, body and soul, were assumed into heaven. Theologically speaking, death is a “natural consequence of original sin.” But because Mary was conceived without sin, and played a pivotal role in salvation history, her reward for her faithfulness, her “fiat,” was to be reunited with her Son without “corruption of the body.”

We don’t find any references to this in Scripture, but rather in the tradition of the Church. It might be easy to think of the Assumption as reminiscent of the characters’ experience in the movie, “Cocoon:” they went to a special place just as they were. But our faith is not a movie; it is not science fiction. It is an unbroken line from sin to salvation, from death to life. Just as Christ is the new Adam, Mary is the new ark that we read about in Revelations. She carries the promise, literally God’s promise, to the Israelites, and to us today.

Mary’s willingness to accept her future, a future for which she praises God for allowing her participation, is an encouragement to all. Each parent who holds a newborn child can mirror Our Blessed Mother in absolute trust in the Lord. They know, as Mary knew, that moving with God’s plans can bring great joy as well as sufferings, for we, as Mary, do not escape life’s realities. Whether or not we have ever been parents, the lesson is the same: strength and submission are not mutually exclusive. Mary was not weak, nor are we when we place our trust in God.

Today, in 2021, what does the Assumption mean for us? Is this just another feast day when we feel compelled to attend Mass? No. This feast, in the middle of Ordinary Time, reminds us of the ultimate goal and result of our faith: reunification with Our Father in heaven. So many months after His own Resurrection, the Assumption reaffirms that Christ’s suffering for our sake had real purpose. It is not just the Son of Man who rose to be with His Father, but also the Sons and Daughters of Adam who will experience the same.

Pope Francis referred to Mary as the “gate of heaven;” by your example, will you be a gate for others?
