Welcome Sister Marijo Valenton, SNDS, our new Director of Pastoral Outreach to the STM family! A member of the Sisters of Our Lady of LaSalette, Sister was born in the Philippines and came to the U.S. in 2001 serving the diocese as the Assistant Catholic Chaplain at Fairfax

Hospital. There she ministered to the sick and their families for 18 years. From 2019-2020 she worked parttime at her community's mission in Normandy, France educating visitors "not about war, but about peace and reconciliation. We spoke of the peace that the brave men bought with their lives there. God wants us to have that peace in our lives, wherever we go."

Upon her return in 2020, Sister worked with the Religious Education program at St. Mary of Sorrows in Fairfax. At STM, Sister will visit homebound parishioners bringing Communion and companionship. "It is important that those who can't be with us in person continue to feel a part of the parish and remembered by us," says Fr. Posey. Sister agrees, "It's important to receive Christ, but also to talk to him. [The homebound] are a part of the Church and we should [remind them] that the Church comes to them too.
