

From Our Rector

"Strengthen the hands that are feeble, make firm the knees that are weak, say to those whose hearts are frightened: Be strong, fear not! Here is your God ... he comes to save you." Isaiah 35: 3-4

As a priest I wear the pink of Gaudete Sunday and light the candle in joyful anticipation of the birth of our Savior. I secretly (or not so secretly) play Christmas carols during these days of Advent. Yet the readings today encourage me to patient. Wait. All good things in their time.

What struck me anew were Isaiah's words of encouragement. At my age the lines about weak knees ring truer than I would like. Both the prophet and the evangelist look towards better days when the rains come and our "ransom," our salvation, is secured.

But what if better days seem long gone or too far in the distance? In recent weeks our local community has seen the death of three young persons through accident and illness. I find myself thinking of these families especially today. While I don't want to be a "downer" on a day which is literally meant for joy, I think it's important to acknowledge that for some this is not a joyful Sunday. Perhaps they are reading this on their phone in a hospital room, or at home after an argument or a disappointment. Perhaps their bodies or minds are failing them or those of a loved one. Perhaps they are "frightened."

Dear friends, my vocation, my faith, wants you to know that it is okay to be afraid, but we must not let that fear overtake our trust in God. You may be in a desert now, but you do not have to remain. There are those who can lead you out. God is not a mirage; he exists in you and in others who can be as him to you.

While we're told to be patient for Christ's arrival, I would say no. Be impatient. Bring to others his message now. "Pray without ceasing." Be the herald that "bring[s] glad tidings" today.

You don't have to wait until December 25.




