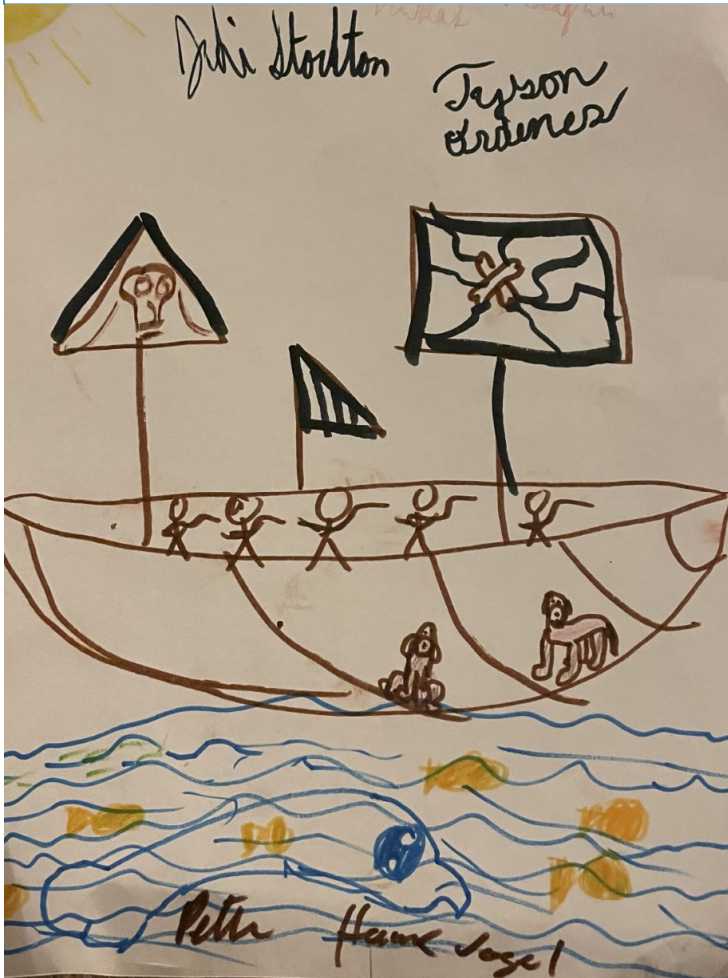

Is 11: 1</p> <p>What do we look for in a leader? Strong? Brave? Inciteful, or visionary? Perhaps we may toss in compassionate, kind. Isaiah gives us a few ideas: "a spirit of wisdom and of understanding, a spirit of counsel and of strength, a spirit of knowledge and of fear of the LORD. ... Not by appearance shall he judge, nor by hearsay shall he decide, but he shall judge ... with justice."</p> <p>Centuries ago, Israel decimated by war and led by corrupt monarchs, desperately needed the hope that a new ruler could bring. From that "stump" of wayward kings, a Messiah would come, and the Israelites would realize what they had sought for so long: peace and unity. John the Baptist is the new Isaiah shouting from the wilderness that had become the soul of the Jewish people. Those lions and lambs resting together. Gentiles and Jews, free and servants, all existing together in harmony.</p> <p>I don't know about you, but National Geographic usually shows lions and lambs in an entirely different situation; and we don't encourage our children to play with poisonous snakes. Moreover, we have yet to fulfill our promise to be just in our dealings with each other and with our God.</p> <p>But. "[B]y endurance and ... encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope." We are not a lost cause. As I wrote in my Thanksgiving message, we are children of God created out of love, to love, and to be loved. While Isaiah's dream and John the Baptist's exhortations may seem far-fetched, they are within our grasp if only we are attentive to their message and to the one who shares that message.</p> <p>Advent literally means "coming." We can live our lives in a perpetual state of waiting for our Savior or we can heed the prophets and recognize that here, and now, he is in our midst. Let us be the new prophets who herald the Christ in our daily lives.</p> <p>Country Christmas returns this Saturday. I hope to see you as we celebrate the season with food, fellowship, and even a few barnyard friends. No lions, but perhaps some lambs! Remember to register and take a chance on our 50/50 raffle whose proceeds will benefit the Holy Family Hospital in Bethlehem.</p> <p>God Bless. Fr. Posey</p>
