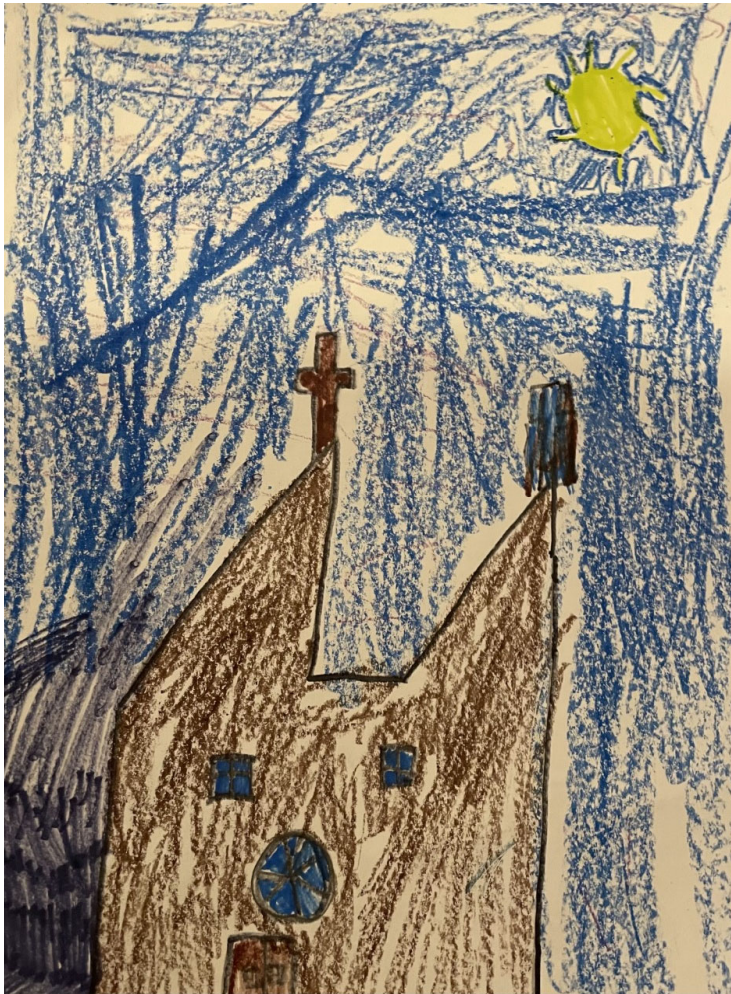

From Our Rector

"Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets. I have come not to abolish but to fulfill."
Matthew 5:17

There is a reason that the Evangelist Matthew's work is the first Gospel in the New Testament. Historically, it is the earliest to be written (c. 70CE) but a larger theme takes prominence: it establishes Jesus as the realization of the Messianic promise. Matthew's audience was primarily Jewish Christians and by starting with the genealogy, he establishes Jesus' rightful lineage and kinship with kings.

At this point in the Gospel, Jesus has just begun his ministry. He has called his followers. He has, through the Beatitudes revealed how we are to live: to be merciful, to be humble; to care for those who suffer and to proclaim "righteousness." Jesus goes on to show that his teachings do not refute but rather deepen centuries-old lessons. "You have heard it said..." is fulfilled with "but I say to you." Christ at once establishes his authority as law-giver and the demands of true discipleship.

We are all called to be holy and how do we live this out but to follow the commandments; to follow not just the letter of the law, but its spirit as well. Can we say we adhere to the 5th commandment not to kill when we engage in hateful gossip and slander against another? When we "shine ... light" from the bushel our words must reflect our deeds.

Our world is rife with examples of hypocrisy; from entertainers to politicians, to, yes, even those within our own Church. These "lights" often eclipse the radiance of those who work for justice; who seek commonality; who show kindness and compassion without fanfare. It is up to us, to you and me, to be the "salt" that enhances the spiritual life of others.

Be More than just a slogan; be the idea behind it.

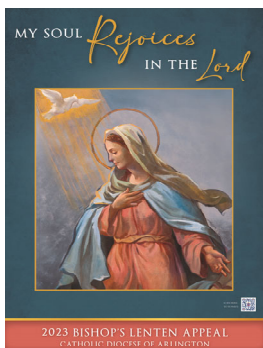

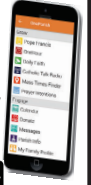
