The Evangelist relates this famous scene where Satan tempts Christ with three basic human weakness: hunger, power, and the desire for material gain or comfort. He tries to trick Jesus by quoting Scripture only to have Christ use it to his advantage. Baptized and proclaimed God’s “beloved Son,” Jesus confirms this by obeying and honoring his Father.

What Jesus faced in the desert, we also face. We all want to avoid discomfort, physical, emotional, and psychological. So we may “feel better” by having that extra slice of pizza, taking that drink. We may ignore difficult people or situations which require us to confront our own mortality or shortcomings.

Moreover, we would all like to be the masters of our fate; to have control over our own “dominions.” We have watches, computers and other devices which can schedule and remind us. From 10:00-10:30 I will do this; on Friday I will do that. How do we react to the unplanned? Do we “curse the darkness” instead of “lighting a candle?” (By the way, the Light is On for the Sacrament of Confession every Wednesday from 6:30-8:00pm in addition to our regular hours.)
