**“God put Abraham to the test.” Genesis 22:1**

There is a lot of testing in the past few weeks of Scripture: Job, Jesus, and now Abraham. Job lost everything yet he “believed even ... when [he was] greatly afflicted.” (Ps 116:10) Jesus revealed his humanity along with his sovereignty in the desert, tempted but stressing that “you shall not put the Lord your God to the test.”

The scene in Genesis is transformative; revealing Abraham’s identity as devout, and willing to sacrifice his most precious gift to God. In Mark, God reveals to Peter, James, and John who Jesus really is: “my beloved Son,” whom He is also ready to sacrifice.

Now put your name in that Genesis quote: “God put \_\_\_\_ to the test.” What would you reveal about yourself? Though God does not “demand burnt offerings,” what would you sacrifice to show your devotion? Would you believe under great duress? Would your faith survive if the one thing you valued most (a child, a profession, your health or that of a loved one) was taken from you? Would you need a voice from the sky? These questions are not to point fingers or to inspire guilt. How do we know what we believe until that belief is truly confronted ... in the hospital, in the workplace, in your homes? None of us escapes this situation.

We have two choices when we face hardships: we can fall into despair, anger, or bitterness. We can turn a deaf ear to the voice of God. Or we can become stronger: physically, mentally and most importantly, spiritually.

Lent is a time when we can test ourselves; when our sacrifices can be for something greater, when they can bring us closer to God and to those around us. It is a time to find God again in your hearts. When we do that, when we join our sufferings with Jesus’, when we recognize Him in our lives, we can truly say, “Rabbi, it is good that we are here!”
