From Our Rector

"And Mary kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart."

Happy New Year!

It's a fresh start. We've literally turned the page on 2022 and 2023 looks clean; the possibilities are endless: for change of heart, mind, body, and soul. It's a time when we, too, can "reflect" on the previous year and hope for this one.

It's fitting that on a day dedicated to beginnings that the Church recognizes the Mother of God: the new Eve, the one from whom the new Adam would come and right the course of history. Now, I don't have children and as the youngest, was not around too many newborns. But I have seen in the eyes of new parents, especially moms, the hope they have for their children. This coupled with all the questions, worries and fears that I am sure run through their minds; the enormous responsibility weighing heavily.

Mary was no different. The Mother of, God the Second Person of the Trinity, was also the Mother of Jesus, her child whom she was to nurture and raise. She was devout so she knew her Scripture: a Messiah would come to "ransom captive Israel." But. A long treacherous journey so close to giving birth? Doing so in a stable? Among dirty animals far from family? This is how God wants to begin the salvation of humanity?

Luke doesn't tell us Mary's thoughts. She's not yet met Simeon who will reveal that "this child is destined for the fall and rise of many in Israel, (and you yourself a sword will pierce)" With great love comes great sacrifice; and Mary will see her son sacrifice his life. Her heart will break for love of him who will die for love of us.

What things do you keep in your heart? Open yours to Mary who will intercede for you. As this New Year begins, let your faith grow; let your trust in God grow. He has a plan for you, and it is for you to be with him in heaven. On behalf of my brother priests, deacon, faculty and staff, I offer this prayer for you. May it ring true today and always. Fr.
