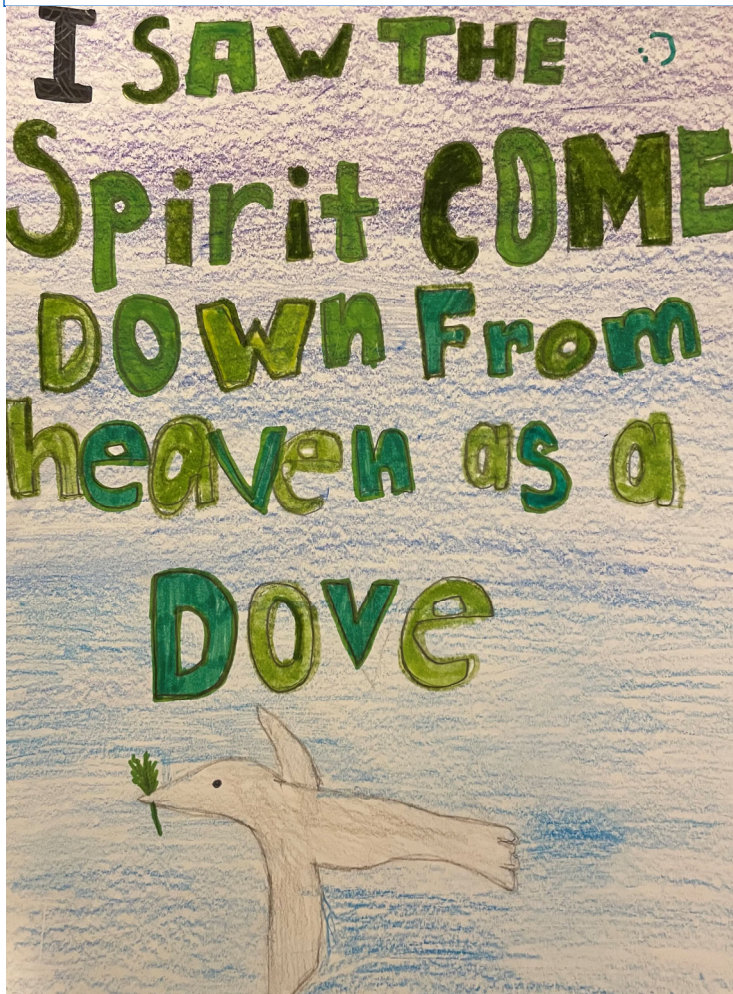

From Our Rector

"Paul, called to be an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God..." 1 Corinthians 1

Paul wrote to this small Christian community he founded amidst a population that, at the time, was known for its immorality. Here he confronted division and personalities who often came before the truth. Paul speaks pastorally, but firmly, even beseechingly at times, for the people to be at peace with one another; to remain faithful to the Gospel witness he bore and which he asks them to imitate.

We don't have the entire epistle to read today, so what exactly are we to get from the Second reading? I had someone recently joke to me that it's basically a "hi there" kind of reading. It's a greeting; it doesn't appear to share a story or a teaching; it doesn't even really seem to say much.

But important words jump out at us: called; sanctified; grace. In these few lines Saint Paul has encapsulated our entire faith. Saved by Jesus, bound in fellowship of the Church, we are all called to be holy. We are called to be God's children.

It's this idea of God reaching out to his people bringing them to him which permeates all the readings today. God speaks to Isaiah; the Psalmist responds to the Lord with "here I am." Most profoundly, God speaks to John the Baptist through the Holy Spirit who in turn does more than simply acknowledge Jesus' divinity: he testifies to it.

We are called a pilgrim church for a reason. Our faith is meant to be shared, and not simply during the heady days of the holidays where it is "socially acceptable." We are the new John the Baptists. Will we answer God's call when he speaks to us through the needs of the poor? Will we answer him when he calls us, or texts, as a loved one seeking forgiveness or connection? Will we answer him when others refute, or even mock, his teachings? Will we be at the foot of the Cross as we were at the creche?

As Paul ends his greeting, (announcing one of his greatest themes), I remind you (and me) that it is by grace that we are saved. And it is enough. We are enough. And it is through, with, and because of this beautiful grace that we can "do all things."

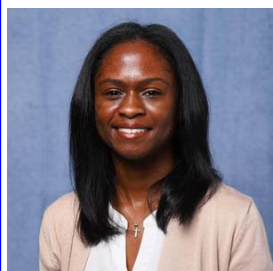
