Jesus’ divinity has been announced by God; his disciples called, and now, to work. Mark takes us on a journey of recognition: that Jesus is truly the Messiah sent to secure our salvation. Yet, from the beginning people do not immediately see this. They are “astonished” and “amazed.” He proclaims in words they can hear and understand; his message is for everyone, not just for the “scribes.” He is like the prophets of old whose words resonated in people’s hearts. But isn’t this the carpenter’s son? Who is he to speak with such “authority?” Today, would we recognize the Messiah in our midst? Or cast them aside as some quack, religious hysteric or worse? Would we “harden our hearts” if we heard His voice?

The second coming of Christ is really in our midst. We are living it now; we have the ability to bring about salvation one person at a time. We can be that prophet, that forbearer of Christ by our words and deeds. This echoes the theme for the **2021 Bishop’s Lenten Appeal**, “to encourage one another.” In a year of pandemic, upheaval and anxiety, we need to be there for one another. Our diocesan programs strive to do this; and our Bishop needs you to assist him. Our goal this year is \$252,000; I hope you will support Bishop Burbidge and all those who work to bring the healing and compassionate heart of Christ to all. 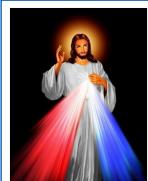

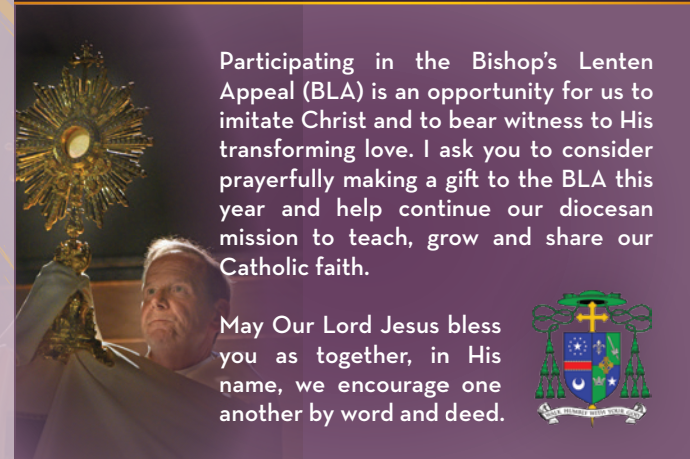

More than 25,578 students enrolled in parish faith formation classes.



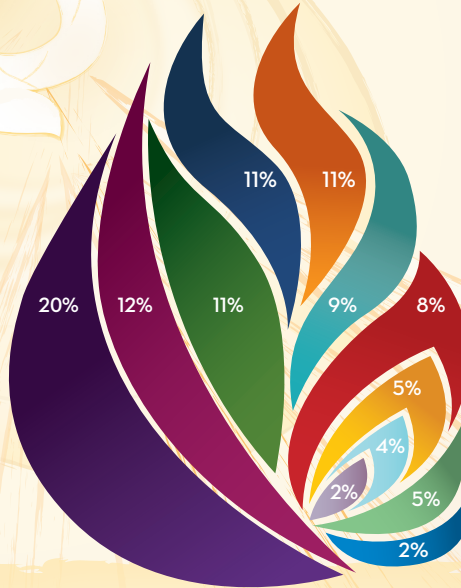
There are 50 men currently studying for the priesthood, who, God willing, will one day serve in our parishes.

Catholic Charities is still experiencing a tremendous influx of requests for rent/mortgage and utilities assistance, groceries and mental health counseling. Additionally, more than 1.3 Million lbs. of food was collected and distributed through Catholic Charities' St. Lucy Project last year!



100% of all donations received for the BLA are restricted gifts to be used within the diocese for the sole benefit of the programs and ministries outlined below.
