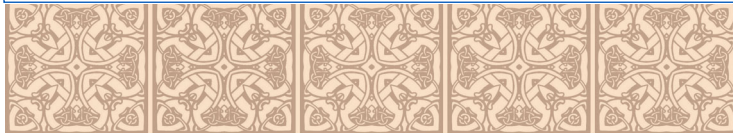

## From Our Deacon

On Friday this week, we will celebrate the new Memorial of Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus. In January of 2021, Pope Francis added Mary and Lazarus to what had previously been a memorial celebrating Saint Martha alone.

The Vatican decree that announced this change references the story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead in John's Gospel. In that account, Jesus learns that his friend Lazarus is ill. His sisters Martha and Mary inform Jesus and the result is a bit baffling. Our Lord does nothing for two days. Where is the urgency?

When Jesus finally arrives, Lazarus has been dead for four days. Understandably, Martha and Mary tiptoe toward reproaching the Lord in their exasperation: "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died." Mary and Martha had their faith tested by Jesus's seemingly slow response. But they trusted, as Martha says, that Jesus is "the Messiah, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world."

That patient trust in the identity of Jesus—who assures us that He is the resurrection and the life—is rewarded. Lazarus "emerged from the tomb at the command of the One who humiliated death," in the words of last January's Vatican announcement.

Martha, Mary and Lazarus are three saints who can help us to understand this Sunday's Gospel, which is all about prayer. Christ invites us to ask, to seek, and to knock in prayer. When their brother was near death, Martha and Mary asked, they sought, and they knocked. And finally, in a manner more wonderful than they could have expected, Christ opened the door.

Did these three siblings understand Jesus's loving plan to "humiliate" death from the outset? No.

Did they face intense hardship along the way (imagine how they felt at the exact moment Lazarus passed away)? Of course!

Did Jesus ever abandon them or fail to hear their prayers? Absolutely not.

The specifics of our personal situations are unique. But the principle that Martha, Mary and Lazarus exemplify for us is the same:

*For everyone who asks, receives;  
and the one who seeks, finds;  
and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.*

Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus, pray for us!

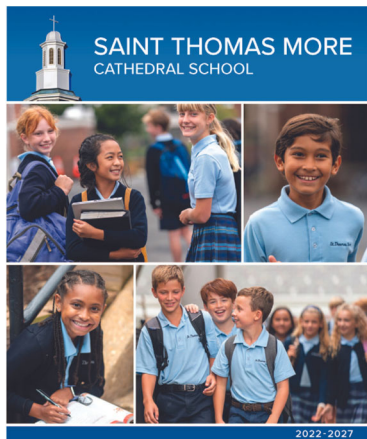
