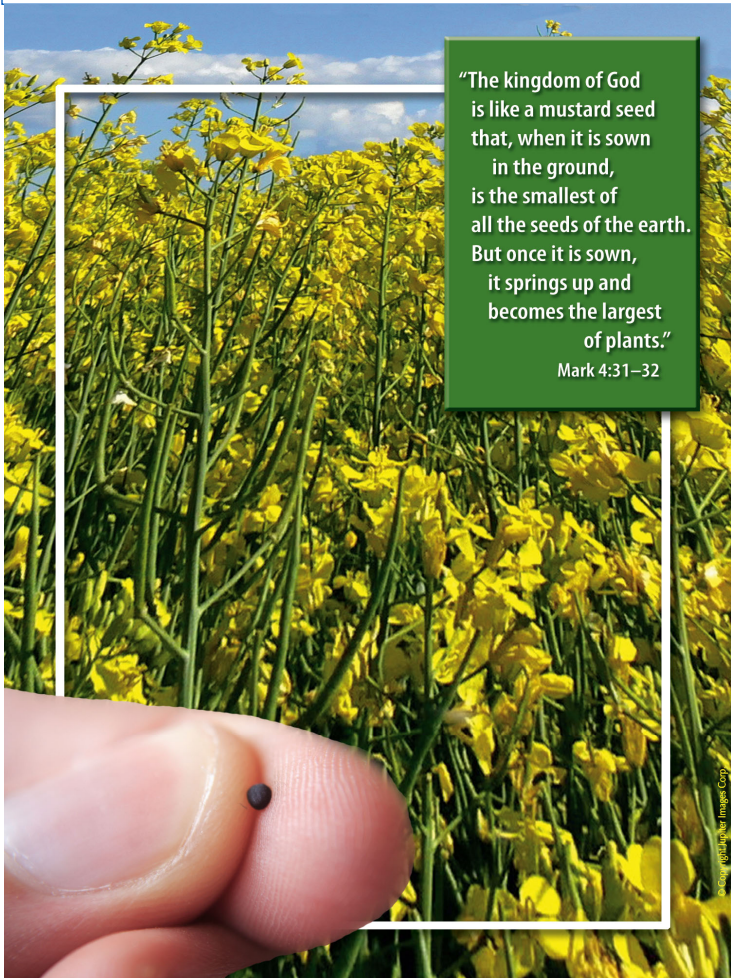

“We walk by faith, not by sight, yet we are courageous.”

Summer in this area means storms; which also means that losing power is inevitable. Sometimes it's not even storms, it's the dreaded internet which can wreak havoc. I can remember one evening last summer a storm left me fumbling around my office. I almost said, "Alexa find the door." Even though I had not been at the Cathedral for that long and we were in the midst of renovating, intellectually I knew where I was. But the dark was disorienting; the chair that I was sure was a few feet to my right met my foot squarely, and rather painfully. After a few embarrassing seconds I reminded myself that I knew where I was going; I knew the path upstairs. Light can make us take our surroundings for granted. We see the things which can be our pitfalls and obstacles.

Faith demands that we abandon the need for physical proof. Two thousand years after Christ talked of mustard seeds and vines we believe not because we saw Jesus Himself, but because we see Him in the world around us and those with whom we share it. This sight asks us to look beyond the shadows, to go beyond the superficial and see the divine. Just as it's not always easy to move in the dark, faith is not always simple; nor does it always follow a straight path. Like the mustard seed which while planted, faith can live or die depending on many factors, but the most important factor is that God is the sower. He gives us the opportunity to grow closer to Him. We must feed that faith with the waters of our baptism and the food of the Eucharist.

Faith also demands trust, to believe even when there is no light to be seen. In times of great distress, faith is our guide and the Holy Spirit our source of courage. It may not lead to a "perfect resolution": loved ones pass, illness attacks, disappointment occurs; but it does lead to grace and the strength to face the darkness and walk.

Next Sunday is National e-Giving Day. Hundreds of our parishioners utilize this safe, secure and simple way for stewardship of our Cathedral. 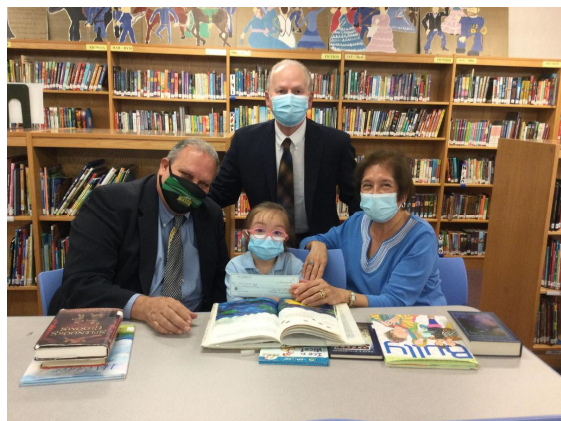
