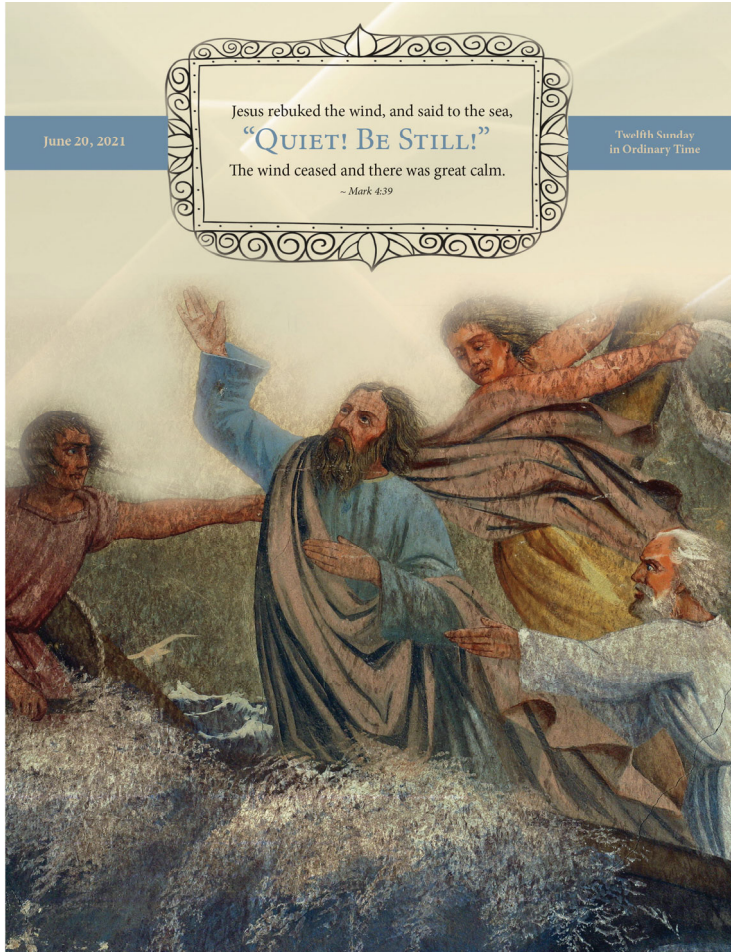

Hello! My name is Deacon Philip Briggs, and I am very excited that Bishop Burbidge has assigned me to serve here at the Cathedral of St. Thomas More. I was just ordained a deacon for the Arlington Diocese on April 10th, and I hope to be ordained a priest next June. I will be living here at the Cathedral throughout the

summer until August, then I will continue my final year of studies at Mount St. Mary’s Seminary. During the school year I will return to the Cathedral on the week-ends to assist with baptisms, weddings, funerals, and preaching at masses.

I was born and raised in Front Royal, Virginia, just about an hour’s drive west on I-66. I come from a family of nine children, six girls and three boys, and most of us were homeschooled through High School. I first felt called to be a priest when I was seventeen years old. At first, I was a bit afraid of the thought of the priesthood, and I thought it would be an impossibly difficult life for me.

However, after bringing these fears to Jesus in Adoration and talking to a few priests I knew, soon those fears melted away. The thought of the priesthood became something that I prayed about frequently, and I looked forward to what Jesus had in store for me in the future. After finishing High School, I attended Christendom College in Front Royal. During my time in college, thoughts of the priesthood were placed on hold, and I thought that God might be calling me to marriage instead. After graduating from college, I spent three years working at a local winery in Virginia where I eventually became the winery’s cellar master.

However, while working at the winery, thoughts of the priesthood kept coming back to me, and I was curious if God was still calling me as he did in High School. After going back to spiritual direction once again, I discerned that God was pulling my heart towards the seminary. After applying with the Arlington Diocese, Bishop Loverde sent me to study at Mount St. Mary’s Seminary where I’ve studied the past five years.

Please remember me in your prayers as I seek the Lord’s guidance in my preparations to be His servant.

At the Cathedral of St. Thomas More, the Religious Education Program is available to children in grades 1st-High School.

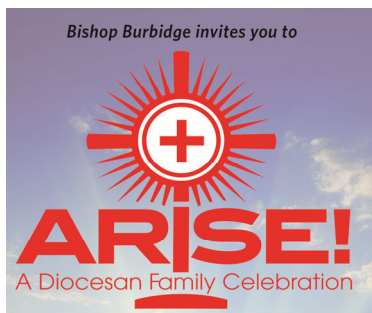

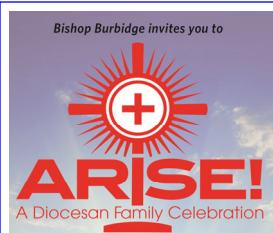

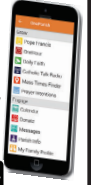
