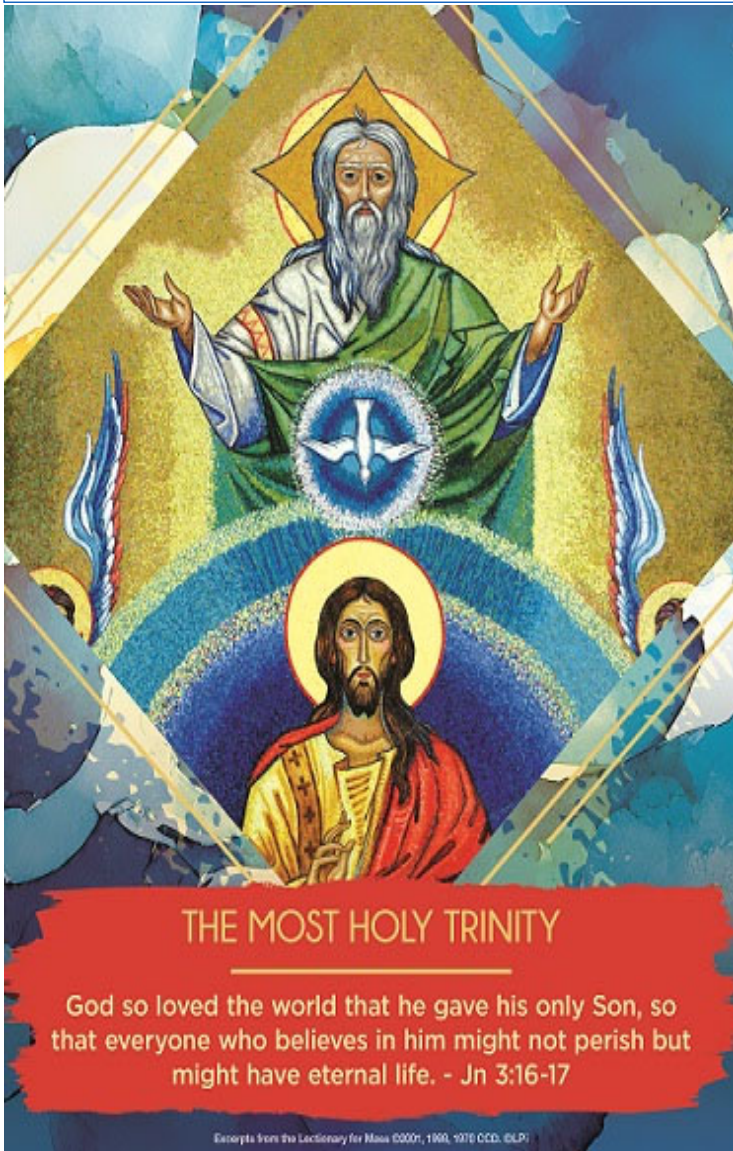

From Our Rector

"God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." John 3:16

In terms of sheer recognizability, this verse from Saint John is iconic. It has found its way onto bumper stickers and greeting cards; it is ever-present at our sporting events, prompting I am sure quite a few people to Google it.

In terms of our faith, it encompasses the entirety of our relationship with God and his with us. All the readings before, after, and surrounding this one line prepare, support, and maintain this simple yet awesome fact: God created us out of a love so profound that even when we had turned away from him in sin, he sacrificed his own son for our salvation.

In the ancient world, the thought of a God who sacrifices is incredible. In speaking to Nicodemus, Jesus is once again turning the Judaic tradition on its head: it takes Abraham's sacrifice of Isaac to a new level. God offers, he does not take. Jesus comes not to "condemn" but to save. God requires not "burnt offerings" but love.

This is a fitting bookend to our Easter season. John reminds us of just why we have been celebrating. Not just did Jesus rise, but we can rise with him. We can celebrate the eternal Easter with him if only we believe.

Has this truth found its way into your heart? Do you really and truly believe that you are worth his sacrifice? Do you believe that no matter how long it has been since you have been to Mass, been to Confession he still calls you? Do you believe that no matter how many hurts you have caused, no matter how many fears, disappointments, or questions you have he still waits? Do you believe that there is a room for you in his house? Do you believe that others are equally deserving? One of my favorite quotes comes from *Les Misérables*, "to love another person is to see the face of God."

Believe, and show, that our relationship with our Father, and each other, is more than just a poster at a football game.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our diocesan priests dedicate their lives to serving and guiding us on our life-long journey of faith. They have administered the sacraments, preached the Gospel, encouraged and prayed for us and our families. They look forward to peace in their retirement years, while continuing to pray for our diocese and God's holy people. Many priests continue to minister and offer their priestly services in retirement.

Currently there are 195 diocesan priests serving in our diocese. Of these, 29 priests are retired, and over the next ten years, 18 additional priests will reach retirement age.

On *June 10-11*, at all Masses, the annual second collection for retired priests will take place in the parishes of our diocese.

This special collection will provide funds for clergy post-retirement health care, nursing home care, and the priests' pension fund. The collection also assists several specific needs, including the ongoing operational expenses of the *Saint Rose of Lima Priests Retirement Villa*, a residence for up to 15 priests.

I ask you to be as generous as possible so that our priests, who have faithfully served the People of God in our diocese, may be cared for in their retirement years.

May Our Risen Lord Jesus bless you with the gift of His peace and watch over you always.

Estimados hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Nuestros sacerdotes diocesanos dedican su vida a servirnos y a guiarnos en nuestro peregrinaje de fe durante toda la vida. Han administrado los Sacramentos, predicado el Evangelio, nos han alentado y han rezado por nosotros y por nuestras familias. Aspiran a vivir en paz en sus años de jubilación, mientras siguen rezando por nuestra diócesis y por el pueblo santo de Dios. Muchos sacerdotes siguen en su ministerio y ofrecen sus servicios sacerdotales durante la jubilación.

En la actualidad, hay 195 sacerdotes diocesanos al servicio de nuestra diócesis. De ellos, 29 están jubilados y, en los próximos 10 años, otros 18 llegarán a la edad de jubilación.

Los días 10 y 11 de junio se realizará la segunda colecta anual para los sacerdotes jubilados durante todas las Misas en las parroquias de nuestra diócesis.

Esta colecta especial proporcionará fondos para atención de salud, cuidados en hogares geriátricos y el fondo de pensiones para los sacerdotes después de la jubilación. La colecta también permite ayudar a atender varias necesidades específicas, incluso a sufragar los constantes gastos de operación de la Villa Santa Rosa de Lima para Sacerdotes Jubilados, una residencia con un cupo máximo para 15 de ellos.

Les pido su generosidad en la mayor medida posible para que nuestros sacerdotes, que han servido fielmente al pueblo de Dios en nuestra diócesis, puedan recibir cuidado en sus años de jubilación.

Que Nuestro Señor Jesús Resucitado los bendiga con el don de su paz y vele por todos ustedes siempre.

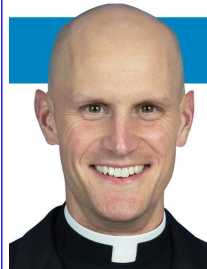
Volunteers are needed for WorkCamp security.

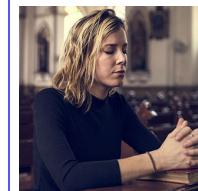
