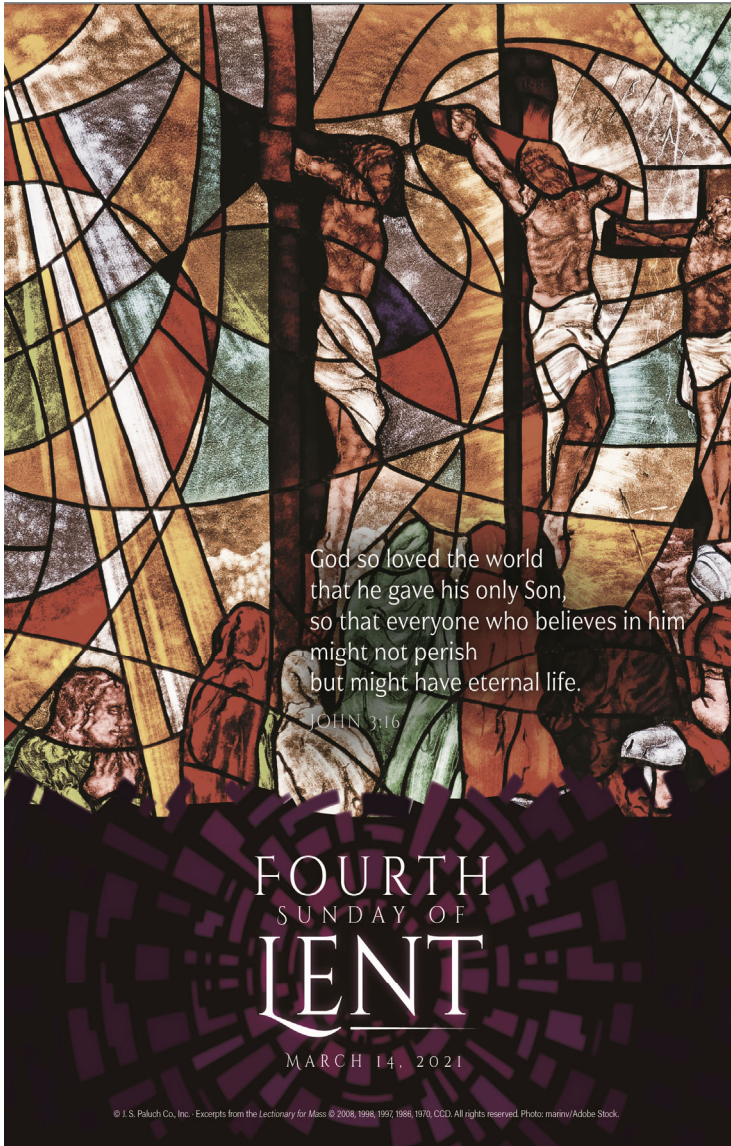

“For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.”

If I were to ask you what John 3:16 said, I am sure you would quote this verse right away. We know it from bumper stickers, signs at sporting events, t-shirts etc. If Jesus condensed 10 commandments into two (love God with all your heart and love your neighbor as yourself), this verse encapsulates the entirety of our faith. Martin Luther even referred to it as “the gospel in miniature.” God created us out of love and for love. His desire is to breach the chasm of sin reuniting us with Him forever.

If we recall how Abraham was willing to sacrifice Isaac, and how profound that sacrifice would have been, how much more amazing and life altering is it that God gave us His Son, Jesus. “If you who are evil know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!” (Matthew 7:11)

Follow the reading further and you arrive at the problem for many modern-day Christians: “whoever does not believe has already been condemned.” We want our God to be merciful, and He is. We want Him available to everyone, and He is. We want everyone saved, and they can be. But they must turn away from “infidelity heaped upon infidelity;” they must be willing to accept the grace offered by Jesus’ sacrifice.

If I am to be saved, of course I’ll accept it. But as every parent knows (from what I’m told), some children can rebel against what is good for them, and what can lead them to ultimate happiness and right relationships. Yet they, like God, continue to reach out to them, to sacrifice, to hope. As adults we rebel as well. We take shortcuts, we live “for the moment,” we “mock the messenger.”

Lent calls us to remember that we are, as Saint Paul says, God’s “handiwork.” We are His creations and as such, He wants nothing more than to bring us closer to Him. Lent reminds us of sacrifice, but it also reminds us of redemption.

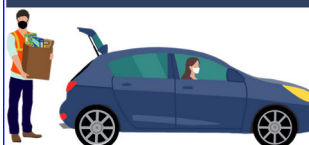


Our Novena to Saint Joseph Concludes March 18.
