From Our Rector

“Be with me, Lord, when I am in trouble.”

As a priest I have sat and prayed in hospitals, private homes, and the confessional for the relief of distress. Many have wondered about the redemptive power of suffering. Amid great trials some have even said to me that there is no point to pain, that they can gain perspective in far easier ways. I have to say, I understand their point. No one likes pain. There's a reason it's called “The Agony in the Garden.” In his humanity Christ knew fear; he knew what awaited him at the top of the hill.

As I write this, Russia has waged unjustifiable war against Ukraine and once again, a history so ripe with tragedy and destruction seems ready to repeat itself. Images of pain, fear, and suffering are never further away than our phones or computers. While God may never feel farther away during times of trial, it is precisely then he is closest to us. “He shall call upon me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in distress.”

Where is he then?

He is here in our world, but perhaps we don't recognize him. We need to see him through the compassion of those who are assisting Ukrainian refugees; through the skilled hands of first responders coming to their aide, and through the minds and hearts of those working to defeat aggression and secure peace.

This is exactly what we must practice at home. Whether we hear it from a mountain top or a plain, we need to be what Jesus calls us to be: peacemakers; to sow seeds of unity, not division. I ask you, my dear sisters and brothers, to be that “channel” of God's peace. In your everyday life, at home or at work, be that recognizable face of Christ.

If this were easy, we would have perfect harmony in our world, but clearly, we do not. Current events all too painfully remind us of this fact. It was for us that Christ emptied himself completely upon the Cross; but not before asking God if it could be avoided. His is a lesson of selflessness resulting in the greatest gift we have, salvation through forgiveness. Bound not with chains of war but with the freedom of Christ's love, let us bring pardon, understanding, compassion, and charity.

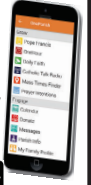
