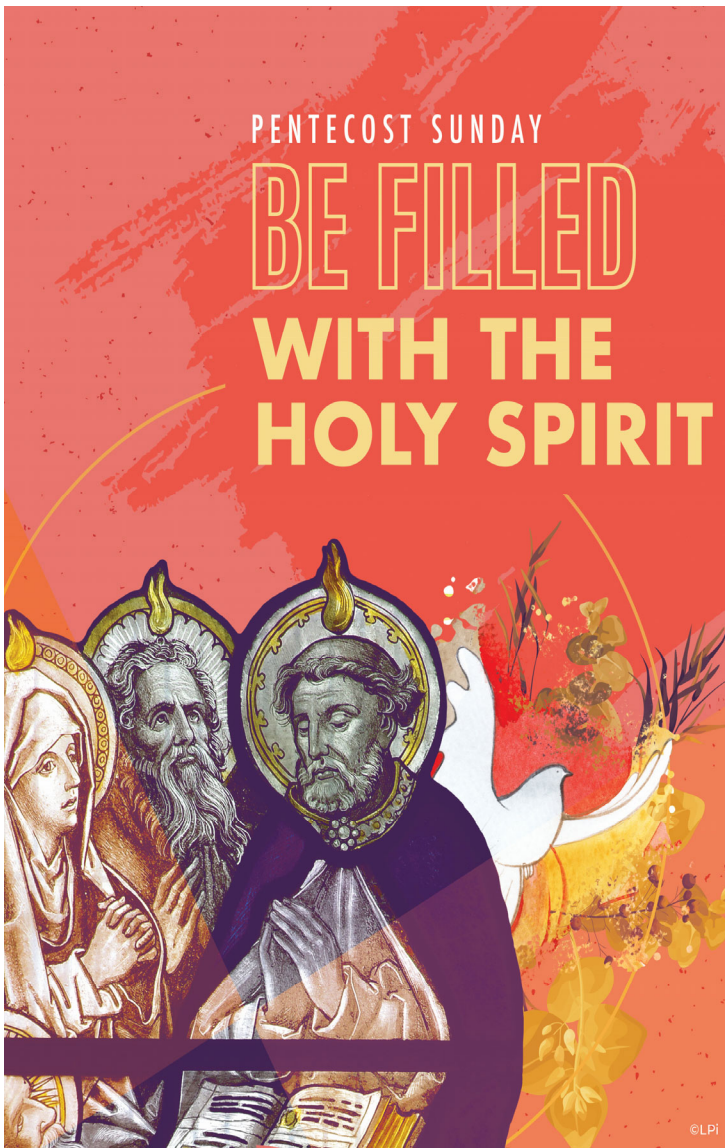

*Jesus said to them again, “Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.”*

*“A true missionary who never ceases to be a disciple, knows Jesus walks with him, speaks to him, breathes with him, works with him” Pope Francis*

It’s hard to miss the changes that are happening to our Cathedral. Scaffolding and fencing have been erected all in preparation for what promises to be a testament to artistic and sacred beauty. While we are in a time of adjustment, we know that our Christianity resides not simply within a building; it is part of who we are as a people. It propels us forward and outward; we become, literally, the mission.

My clerics reveal my vocation and the purpose by which I live. People may be drawn to me and other religious by our outward appearance – to question, to learn or even to heal. You, the good people of Saint Thomas More, reveal your discipleship not necessarily in clothing, but by your actions. I love that “pay it forward” commercial where one good deed, seemingly done in anonymity but witnessed by one, inspires another to go out of their way. The pattern is repeated throughout the ad and what it reminds us is that people are paying attention.

There is a well-known quote which says, “[O]nly a disciple can make a disciple.” If we do not actively witness our faith through kindness, compassion and mercy, our churches would eventually empty because the ruse would be revealed. Our faith endures precisely because we live it, even when it is hard to do. We reach out to others even if we ourselves are hurting or damaged. We go out when we’d rather stay in because we are called to do so. We bring others to Christ in ways great and small. This week, I ask you to look within yourself and see how to show your discipleship to others. It can be a kind word, or a gesture; it can be a phone call to a friend; it could be perhaps an hour of volunteer service. However you choose, I ask you to “pay it forward.”

This weekend we honor those who gave completely of themselves in service to our country. Their example is the supreme act of paying it forward. Their sacrifices for our country continue to inspire generations. To them and their families, we owe a debt of gratitude.

Cathedral Renovation Updates

A covered walkway was constructed at the front entrance of the Cathedral. Please use the new entrance to access Burke Hall. In addition, as Forrester Construction Company begins exterior work, there will be a need to bump out the fence near the Baptism of Christ stained glass window. Mass attendees will be re-routed up the ramp and down the stairs which are in front of the Rectory office. Please note that the accessible entrance that leads to the elevator as well as the sidewalk along Cathedral Lane are also convenient routes to access Burke Hall for Mass.

After reviewing scheduling and seating over these first few weeks, we have decided to combine the 4:30 and 6:00pm Saturday Vigil Masses and return to one Mass at 5:00pm. We are omitting the 12:45pm Sunday Mass. As always, we are grateful for your understanding and patience.

Please note that the Rectory Office and School will be closed Monday, May 29, in observance of Memorial Day. There will be one Daily Mass at 10:00am. The Office and School will reopen on Tuesday, May 30.

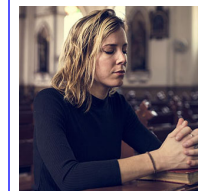
