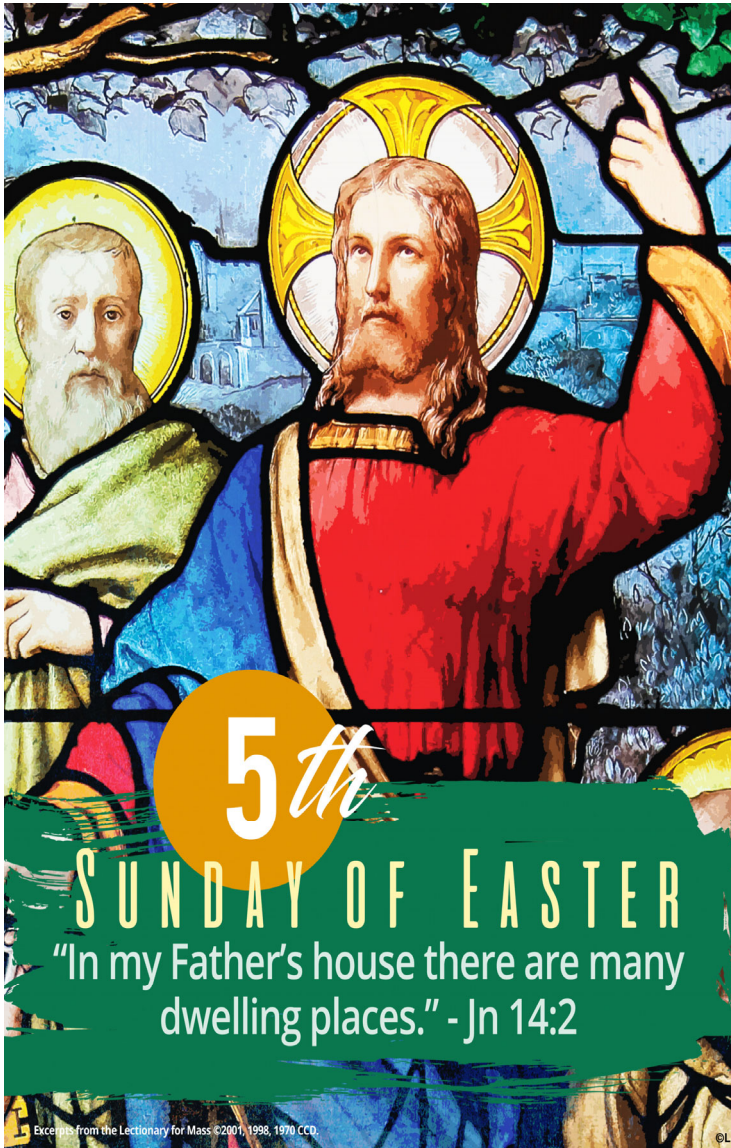

"Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me. In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you?"

This reading from John is often used at funeral Masses. Meant to offer comfort to a grieving family, these words offer assurance that God has remembered their loved one. As he knows the “numbers of hair upon” our heads, he does not forget us. This message of solace is offered to the disciples.

It’s helpful if we take this reading in context. While this is the Fifth Sunday in Easter, the Gospel returns to the Last Supper. In the verses before our reading, Jesus foretells Judas’ betrayal and Peter’s denial. He explains that his hour has come, and he will “only be with them a little while longer.” It’s not a stretch to imagine their confusion and dismay.

It is not enough for the disciples to believe in God, for surely they do. But they must believe that Jesus is the way to God, the truth of God. As the Good Shepherd, he leads us to his Father. But still, they do not understand this. Three years, many miracles, many teachings, they still can’t quite make that connection.

The disciples want a roadmap, they want directions. So do we. In our own lives we rely on Google Maps or Waze to get us from Point A to B. But what we fail to understand sometimes is that it is only through a personal relationship with Jesus that we can come to the Father, to our “dwelling place.” Our “restless hearts” finally finding peace in him.


This relationship is central to our Catholic belief and informs our daily life. As we grow in love with Jesus, we can share that love with others. Christ’s invitation to his table of plenty is offered every time we act as witnesses of the Good News. Let us resolve to open our hearts to others that “they may see the good that we do and give glory to God.”

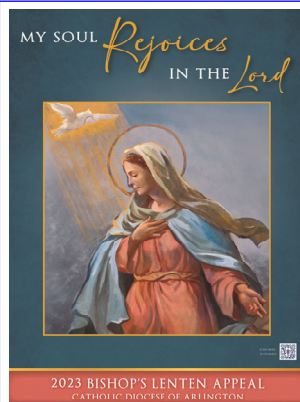

Cathedral Renovation Updates

Last week, a covered walkway was constructed at the front entrance of the Cathedral. Please use the new entrance to access Burke Hall. In addition, as Forrester Construction Company begins exterior work, there will be a need to bump out the fence near the Baptism of Christ stained glass window. Mass attendees will be re-routed up the ramp and down the stairs which are in front of the Rectory office. Please note that the accessible entrance that leads to the elevator as well as the sidewalk along Cathedral Lane are also convenient routes to access Burke Hall for Mass.

After reviewing scheduling and seating over these first few weeks, we have decided to combine the 4:30 and 6:00pm Saturday Vigil Masses and return to one Mass at 5:00pm. We are omitting the 12:45pm Sunday Mass. As always, we are grateful for your understanding and patience.
