

Special Religious Development (SPRED) is a program designed to support and serve children with developmental disabilities, such as Down syndrome, Autism, and Learning Disabilities. The SPRED program invites those with disabilities to come together in a small faith community to discover God's presence in their lives and to receive the Sacraments of Initiation, based on individual levels of readiness. St Thomas More is seeking to bring SPRED to the Cathedral community in early 2023, but adult volunteers are needed. SPRED pairs up an adult friend with a student for a one-to-one ratio in the classroom. These adult catechists are given all the materials they need for every lesson plan, and as a group prepare for each session which includes crafts, music, snacks, and a spiritual lesson connected to Mass, scripture, and daily life. If you are over 18 years of age and interested in working with people with disabilities, please consider volunteering with the SPRED Program. You will receive far more than you can ever give!
