From Our Rector

"I lift up my eyes toward the mountains; whence shall help come to me? My help is from the LORD, who made heaven and earth." Ps 121

How many times have we prayed to God, bargained, and begged, only to find ourselves in a relationship, a job, or a situation that we never could have imagined would be ours? While the readings this weekend encourage us to be persistent, it is so easy to give up; to grow angry; to say, "God, why don't you hear me?" I recall talking with a parent, distraught over a child's illness, who in their hurt blurted an expletive at God and his seeming distance. Apologizing to me for the language, I replied that "I can take it; and God can too."

My sisters and brothers, God does hear you; from the hills described in the Psalms, from classrooms during exams, from hospital rooms and living rooms he does not turn a deaf ear. My parents used to say to me that God answers all prayers; and sometimes "the answer is no." Even the Rolling Stones remind us that we "can't always get what you want; sometimes you get what you need."

"Unanswered" prayers can lead us to greater gifts: patience, trust, humility, acceptance. This isn't easy and I won't pretend to say it is. For how can we accept a bad diagnosis or failed relationship?

We can't; not on our own. Moses needed Aaron and Hur to support his weakened arms. The battle could not be waged and won simply by one person. So too, our hearts are strengthened by the care of others and the mercy of God. Your prayers for me provide the grace I need to be "God's servant." Jesus' sacrifice on the Cross ensures my salvation.

This week I ask you to pray for three things: in gratitude to God for what you do have in your life; acceptance of his will; and for someone you know who needs spiritual care. Together let us persevere and by our lives "proclaim his word."

This week you will receive our Annual Report in the mail. Thank you for your support of each other and our mission. I will review this next week at the Masses and ask you to prayerfully consider your role as stewards of our faith and fellowship. God bless.


