

"Lord increase our faith."

Luke's Gospel is a playbook for discipleship. We are called: all of us, regardless of gender or economic station, to be Christ's followers. Through word and witness, Jesus reveals what is necessary to secure the kingdom of heaven here. Now. To be trustworthy. To be forgiving. To be welcoming. To love God and to love each other.

Still, the disciples ask for more. What more must God give for them to believe not just in Him, but in themselves? Yet, they doubt in the storm; they scatter on the road to Calgary. They have what they need if only they would acknowledge it and see what their faith demands of them: to become a "servant."

The text sounds harsh: "Prepare something for me to eat. Put on your apron and wait on me while I eat and drink." The relationship seems so transactional. Is the master "grateful to that servant because he did what was commanded?" I recall my parents saying to me "why should we give you a present simply because you did what you were supposed to do?"

Following Christ is not always easy and simply because we are baptized into our Christian faith does not mean we immediately pass Go and collect our \$200 Monopoly money. In a very real way we are called to be counter cultural. When others shout of vengeance, we whisper forgiveness; when they close doors, we open them to the refugee, the lonely, the poor. When everything around us moves us away from each other, to view each other in stark one-dimensional lines, Christ calls us to love and to see one another as children of God.

We are reminded that while God doesn't demand "burnt offerings," he does demand that we place him first above all things and people. We don't earn a place at the table. We are not rewarded by God for right behavior. God owes us nothing.

But he gives us everything. His sacrifice saved us. His grace saves us anew and enables us to "walk humbly" with him.
