

From Our Rector

The other day I was saying prayers at a funeral home when there was a huge noise outside the chapel door. Every time a mourner opened the door, the noise was overwhelming. This juxtaposition of mourners in quiet prayer and that of the "party" atmosphere on the other side was startling. It appears that the funeral home had two very different viewings scheduled at the same time.

Viewings (or wakes) fulfill our Christian promise to pray for the living and the dead. Though sorrowful and sometimes uncomfortable, prayers offered at a viewing serve a dual purpose: they are intercessory on behalf of our loved one, and supportive for their family and friends. Readings and prayers at this time remind us of the hope of the Resurrection for us all.

Though right and proper that we extol the positive at viewings, it is also fitting that we acknowledge the need for prayer -- for the departed and for us. Recently someone recounted that at their brother's funeral the priest spoke of course of his virtues, but also that he knew his faults (and the presider even listed some) yet the departed knew the sustenance as well that comes from the Sacraments and prayerful reflection. And so we too are reminded at viewings and funerals that we are all flawed. Yet Christ in his redeeming embrace mends the broken and heals our hearts.

During November we remember especially the departed, offering our Masses, prayers, and other devotionals for their souls. Remember to mention in your last wishes a desire for some sort of vigil, whether a rosary or scriptural readings, but that you want people to pray for you; and that you want a Mass of Christian burial and graveside prayers. While it is true that life goes on, that after the music and prayers people literally drive away to their everyday realities, the one inescapable truth is that we cannot truly "drive away" from the reality of death. Our actions do indeed have consequences and it is only through a life lived faithfully that we will attain our ultimate goal of heaven with our Father. We do not travel this path alone, for we have Christ with us.

Remember that Tuesday is a Holy Day of Obligation for All Saints and that Wednesday we will remember our deceased loved ones at our Mass of Remembrance. I hope you can join us both days.

All holy men and women, pray for us.


