



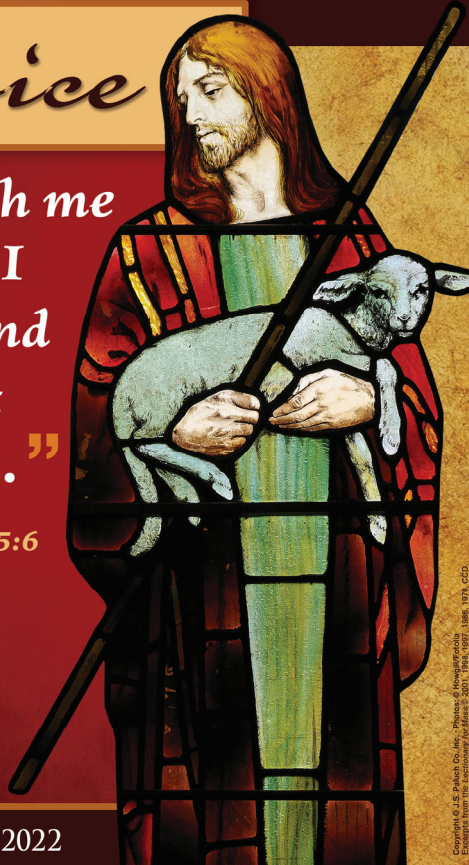

From Our Rector

"All we like sheep have gone astray. We have turned every one to his own Way..." (Isaiah 53: 6)

One of my staff members is rather fond of Handel, in particular his "Messiah." Just this week you could hear Isaiah's words coming from their office. Walking past, this chorus struck me as I knew I would focus my column on an iconic Gospel. How far would a shepherd go to find that one sheep? He was responsible for the well-being of the entire herd. Even one gone could have a financial impact. Jesus takes it father: how far does a father's love extend? Past the hurt, the worry, and perhaps anger towards his wayward child, he discovers the underlying love still there. How far would our heavenly Father go for us? I think we know: up a hill, onto a Cross.

In a way, we are all Prodigals. At some point, we have turned away from God to do our own thing. I believe there are many of us out there, even sitting in our pews, who believe that though they pray among us they are not worthy of being a fully active member of our parish because of their past sins. How can I serve on a ministry or read at Mass? How can I volunteer or serve on a committee? If people knew my past lifestyle they wouldn't want me. Today's Gospel reminds us that the Father does want you as a part of his family; and so do we.

Isaiah tells us in a later verse: "[S]eek the LORD while he may be found; call upon him while he is near." Be willing to change your old sinful ways; ask the Lord's forgiveness in the sacrament of Confession. Pope Francis says to us: "Do we feel weighed down by our sins? Do we think that we won't be able to cope? Let us not close our hearts, let us not lose confidence, let us never give up. There are no situations that God cannot change; there is no sin that he cannot forgive if only we open ourselves to him."

The road to peace and reconciliation is open to us all. Join me along the way.

Today also marks a terrible day in our history. The 21st anniversary of the 9-11 attacks remind us of the cruelty and hatred of humanity. But is also revealed the depth of the bravery, compassion, and determination within our spirits. Let us pray for the dead and their families who mourn them. Let us honor them by working for peace and justice in our communities. Eternal rest grant unto them.
