Thomas More</i></p> <p>We've come to the point in Matthew's Gospel where Jesus, already tempted and tested in the desert, reveals to his disciples his ultimate fate. There will be no salvation without sacrifice, and it is a sacrifice, though borne alone and abandoned, to which Christ calls his apostles. And once again, it is Peter, perfectly imperfect Peter, who says what everyone must be feeling but who, once again, misses the point of Christ's ministry.</p> <p>When Jesus rebukes Peter with the famous, "get behind me Satan," he at once wants to rid whatever impediment stands between him and his mission while also reminding Peter that he too needs to "leave behind" whatever prevents him from following Jesus. Peter still sees what he wants to see; his Messiah is an earthly savior and in his vision, he becomes not apostle, but "adversary" to Jesus.</p> <p>How do we see Jesus? What role do we play in salvation history? Do we accept that not only are we to bring ourselves to Christ, but we must show others the way as well?</p> <p>We have all been Peter: praying for salvation, but perhaps unable or unwilling to do what is needed. It can be easy to stand among the congregation, recite our prayers, hold out our hands for peace and grace. But, when we are faced with sacrifice, when it is our turn to listen to a friend, heal a hurt, care for a child, a parent, a spouse who is ill in body, mind, or spirit, do we say no, this cannot be so?</p> <p>William Butler Yeats once described his war-torn Ireland as a "terrible beauty." So too there will be times when we can truly identify with Christ's sacrifice in times of loss or disruption. It is in those times, oddly, perhaps defying reason, that we can find beauty. In our shared moments of humanity, we can see "as God sees."</p> <p>We celebrate Labor Day on Monday. I pray that you have a relaxing holiday. Let us remember those who work to keep us safe, healthy, and fed. Remember too those who seek employment that their efforts will bear fruit. Let us honor the dignity of all workers with just and fair treatment.</p> <p>God Bless. Father Posey</p>

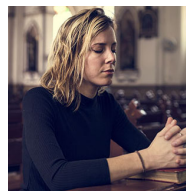
